

Observation Internships

Stipend: No

Observer Interns have the opportunity to study a particular area of ministry in the church (specific areas are listed below). The observation internship is designed to give exposure to the ministry of Tenth Church and partially to meet seminary supervised ministry requirements for men or women. Observation internships, which are unpaid, ordinarily last for at least one semester. Prospective observer interns are required to fill out an application and gain approval from a member of the pastoral staff.

Observers hours are flexible, and often depend on seminary requirements. A member of the pastoral staff or the Tenth Session will serve as an informal mentor during the course of the internship.

Observation internships involve conducting interviews, visiting classes, and attending ministry events. Members of the pastoral staff can recommend a list of related readings. In some cases, it may also be possible to be involved in hands-on ministry. Observers are invited to attend pastoral staff meetings and the monthly intern roundtable.
